

## Bandit Masters Golf Trip: Vannes 2009

- Sunday 20th September ferry: Portsmouth 2030hrs - 08.15 St Malo with 2 berth cabins x 4
- Friday 25th September ferry: St Malo 1030hrs – 18.15 Portsmouth
- Hotel: Comfort Marebaudiere, Vannes or 4 nights, 4 twin/double rooms, B&B
- Golf at St Laurant, La Bretesche, Ploemeur Ocean & Kerver

### **Monday 13.00: Golf de St Laurent** (Par 72, 6,701 yds)

This really is an outstanding links course with the big advantage of being such a short drive from St Malo. Some of the holes which run along the rocky coastline are reminiscent of Turnberry's finest and even on a calm day, this course presents a challenge, but when the wind blows, it becomes very tough. The views along the coastline as you play are outstanding as they are from the clubhouse. Its art deco style, with such detail as stair balusters fashioned out of clubs and balls, is a genuine bonus. ### **Tuesday 11.28: Golf de la Bretesche** (Par 72, 6,578 yds)

On this famous course set in a grand forest, many holes run through dense woodland, so accuracy off the tee is of prime importance. A great variety of landscapes are offered here and the closing holes run around the lake and château, providing an unforgettable golfing experience. ### **Wednesday 11.30 : Golf de Val Queven** (Par 72, 6,673 yds)

Only minutes away from Lorient town, the Quéven-Lorient course runs alongside the river Scorff, skirting woods and crossing valleys. It is a hilly course, with a great variety of holes, featuring several dog-legs with well-positioned water hazards. The greens are in very good shape and the clubhouse is warm and welcoming and has panoramic views. ## Hotel Comfort, La Marebaudiere \*\*\*



**Trip Advisor Review:** The hotel is not easy to find if you arrive by car, but it is worth finding! It is located a 5 minute walk from the walls of the old town and 10 mins from the port. It has a large private and secure car park in a town where parking is a nightmare - park up and walk everywhere! Immediate impressions were positive: the hotel looks good inside and out and the staff on reception were all cheerful, friendly and spoke good English. We paid a little extra at €104 (high season) for a "Grand Comfort" room - very spacious with an enormous bed and a good size seating area. Well worth it for our 3 night stay. The hotel is exceptionally clean. Breakfast is an extra €9 each - a bit expensive but there was a good selection to eat and there were no real local alternatives.

This is a good standard of accommodation at the price, and a very nice location in the very attractive old town of Vannes where a 2/3 day visit allows you to see everything comfortably. Recommended.
