



Bandit Masters Golf Trip: La Baule 2018 13th to 19th September

- Thursday 13th Sept: overnight ferry, Portsmouth 20.15hrs arriving St Malo at 08.15, Friday 14th.
- Friday 14th to Tuesday 18th Sept: 5 rounds of golf.
- Hotel: Mercure La Baule Majestic, 4 nights, 4 twin rooms B&B.
- Tuesday 18th Sept: overnight ferry, St Malo 20:30 hrs arriving Portsmouth at 07.45, Wednesday 19th.

Friday 14th Sept 13.00: International Barrière La Baule

The Lucien Barrière Course (Red): 18 holes, 6230 yds, par 72. Wooded, narrow, and relatively flat, it offers an ideal balance of pleasure and technical skill.

The Diane Barrière-Desseigne Course (Blue): 18 holes, 6,406 yds, par 72. More akin to a traditional American golf course, it has wider fairways with numerous lakes, vast bunkers and wide, well-protected greens.

West of Nantes, in the Brière national park is Golf International Barrière La Baule, boasting two 18 hole championship courses and a nine hole layout, making 45 in total. Since being revamped and expanded, this fantastic course has played host to the French Open so some holes offer the chance to follow in the footsteps of Nick Faldo and Seve Ballesteros. The thatched roofed clubhouse overlooks an outdoor swimming pool.



Saturday 15th 11.04: La Bretesche (5,858 yds, par 72)

Golf de la Bretesche is a must visit when in Western Loire or South Brittany, offering a spectacular setting and a course in immaculate condition. The focal point is the fairy-tale château and lake, with holes skirting around the estate and fairways lined with colourful hydrangeas and rhododendrons. After your round relax in the stone clubhouse or maybe the hotel, all in tastefully converted outbuildings of the old estate.



Sunday 16th 11:06: Golf de Pornic (6,030 yds, par 72)

Located at the heart of a bustling seaside resort is Golf de Pornic. This 18 hole course has plenty of variety on offer, with wide undulating fairways, water hazards and some very well-defended greens. With its seaside location, this course has a holiday atmosphere throughout the year.



Monday 17th 11:00: Golf de Savenay (5,741 yds, par 73)

Between Nantes and St Nazaire is Golf de Savenay, a pleasant course on the edge of the Brière marshes and close to the beaches of La Baule. With varied terrain, chestnut woods, open valleys and water hazards this picturesque golf course is well worth playing.
